

Emergency Planning and Response



Emergency Planning – Being prepared in the event of any emergency is the key to having an effective response. Aquatera staff have prepared numerous emergency plans, covering a range of incident types. Emergency events include: person overboard, evacuation, vessel incidents, oil spills, chemical contamination and wildlife casualties.

This may include responding to third party emergencies, as well as those arising from the device and associated operations.
